

STRINGS QUILT

Quilt-A-Long with Barb Williams

When: Saturday, April 6th workshop will start at 10:30am, but doors will open at 9:30am for fabric prep. * Deadline to register, April Guild Meeting (April 2nd)*

Where: Jeffersonton Community Center

No cost to attend, but you need to bring your own materials (see below)

- Bring snacks/lunch
- Feel free to come enjoy some social time and work on a WIP if you don't want to work on the projects.
- No cost to attend, bring your own materials

MATERIALS LIST:

- Assorted Strips of Fabric any width but at least 10" long (a Jelly Roll will be great and we will be sewing sets of strips aka "strings" together)
- 3 yards of Fabric for Background (Barb used Solid in all three of the quilts shown at February's meeting, but the choice is yours!). From the Background Fabric, you'll need (48) 5" x 5" squares sub-cut into triangles.
 - Defer to you on whether you want to use Charm Packs to match or complement Background Fabric instead of cutting out squares/triangles which would then reduce overall yardage needed in Background fabric
- 6 1/2" square ruler
- Machine, Needle, Thread

(Helpful, but not necessary) personal cutting mat and rotary cutter, mini iron and pressing mat

***Finished Quilt measures 56" x 68" and we should be able to complete the top during the workshop
