

Small Wallet / Purse—which will hold a credit card—supplies are listed below, finished size measures about: 3½" x 4":

- (2) Coordinating fabrics for Outside and Inner Lining:
 - (1) Outer fabric measuring 32cm x 28cm or approximately 12 ¾" x 11"
 - (1) Inner Lining fabric measuring 32cm x 28cm or approximately 12 ¾" x 11"
- (1) Piece of Lightweight fusible stabilizer (like Pellon 101), measuring 32cm x 28cm or approximately 12 3/4" x 11"


Clips or pins

Ripper or Awl

Something to poke/turn out corners

Regular sewing supplies like scissors, thread, sewing machine

Here are the supplies listed for Barb's Big Bag, with a finished size of 24" long x 9" wide x 18" deep:

You have some choices.....

If using 54"-wide fabric:

- 1 ½ yards preferred fabric for outside of bag
- 1 ½ yards coordinating fabric for lining of bag

OR If using an unfinished project:

- 1 pieced top at least 39" x 58"
- 1 ²/₃ yards coordinating fabric for the lining of bag

OR If using 44"-wide fabric:

- 1 % yards preferred fabric for outside of bag
- 1 % yards preferred fabric for outside of bag

OR If the project is to be quilted:

- 1 ²/₃ yards coordinating fabric for the backing
- 39" x 58" piece of batting

Adding a cardboard bottom helps retain the shape of the bag better and offers extra stability when you set it down. To cover the cardboard (optional), you will need:

- 3/8 yard of 54"-wide fabric or 5/8 yards of 44"-wide fabric for lining
- 9" x 24" heavyweight cardboard

Two (2) 3/4" –diameter dowels, each 22" long; can be painted.
